**ASSURETEC AND UNISYS DEPLOY HIGH-TECH I.D.-VERIFICATION SYSTEM
FOR TSA'S REGISTERED-TRAVELER PROJECT**

*– AssureID™ System Operational in Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport;
Upcoming Deployments Scheduled in Los Angeles and Houston –*

Manchester, N.H., July 20, 2004 – In a move that breaks new ground for domestic airport security and travel, AssureTec's AssureID™ document-authentication system has been deployed at the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport. The deployment is part of the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA's) Registered Traveler Pilot Program that provides frequent travelers with an expedited yet highly secure screening experience. TSA is launching the Registered Traveler Pilot Program this summer at five airports nationwide: Minneapolis, Los Angeles, Houston, Boston and Washington DC.

Unisys, the prime contractor selected for the first three Registered Traveler pilot airports, will use the AssureTec system for the program's enrollment-screening process. The AssureTec system was selected for the program because of its ability to scrutinize thoroughly and authenticate the credentials of potential participants.

TSA is using the AssureTec AssureID system as part of the Registered Traveler enrollment process that begins with examination of the volunteers' government identification documents, such as drivers' licenses and passports. These documents are in turn fed into AssureTec's i-Dentify Reader, a highly advanced document authenticator consisting of a camera and multi-spectrum based lighting system that is able to read the document information in less than five seconds. In addition, the system analyzes each document's hidden security features, checking it against authentication attributes.

"Maintaining the absolute highest security measures is the essential element of the TSA's Registered Traveler Pilot Program," says Larry Zmuda, partner, Homeland Security, Unisys U.S. Federal Government Group. "We selected the AssureTec system precisely because it enhances security at the Registered Traveler enrollment stage."
